Weather Related School Closings

Any time the Sheboygan Area School District closes due to weather, Bethlehem will also close. There may however be days SASD decides to stay open, and we close or operate on a delay.

If school closes for the day, Extended Care will also be closed. If there is a two-hour delay, there will be no 3K or 4K classes that day and Extended Care will not open until normal dismissal time at 3:10. If we close early, Extended Care will also close. Please make sure that you pick up your students as quickly as possible.
