Mr. Klug's Corner

- This week we were blessed to welcome Pastor Wolfe from St. Paul Lutheran Church in Sheboygan Falls as our guest chapel leader. His message centered on the theme “Built on the Rock,” drawn from Matthew 7:24-27, where Jesus reminds us that those who hear His words and put them into practice are like a wise builder who builds on a solid foundation.
- Pastor Wolfe brought this message to life with a memorable object lesson using a ladder. He explained that just as a ladder must have secure footing to be safe and effective, our “ladder of life” also needs a firm foundation.
- When our lives are grounded in Jesus, the Rock, we are able to stand strong, even when challenges and storms come our way.
- To reinforce this point, Pastor Wolfe shared a lighthearted but meaningful video of ladder fails, highlighting what happens when ladders and lives are not set on solid ground. The illustration helped students understand that without a strong foundation, things can quickly go wrong.
- We are thankful for Pastor Wolfe’s engaging message and for the reminder that building our lives on Christ provides the stability, safety, and strength we need each day.
